

Yreka Self-Guided Tours

National Historic District

Miner Street Blocks 100 – 300: This is a walking tour for Yreka’s “Old Town”. Begin at the corner of Miner Street and Main. Each historic building has a plaque on the front of the building that gives a bit of the history of that structure. **Free.**

QR Code Tour: Miner Street, Block 100 – 300, Broadway Street to Lane Street, to North Oregon Street. View the QR Codes on the documents you see in the windows of the buildings from your smart phone camera, go to the indicated website and read about the history of these buildings online. Walking Tour. **Free.** Please note parts of this tour are still being completed and QR codes updated.

Third Street Historic Homes: Blocks 100 – 400. The homes have a plaque usually near the front door, naming the original owner or builder and the year it was built. You can either walk or drive for this tour. Purchase a book that gives information in detail about these homes and the people who lived there from the Siskiyou County Historical Society, “*Houses That Talk About Their People and Their Past*”. (Available on their website <http://sisqhistory.org> or at their bookstore located at 320 West Miner Street, Yreka, CA. 96097). **Self-Guided tour is free.** The book is around \$25.

Additional Historic Tours:

Siskiyou County Monuments Driving Tours: Stop in at the Siskiyou County Historical Society located at 320 West Miner Street and pick up their Siskiyou Pioneer Monuments Edition book. It has the monuments listed throughout the county and divided by areas. Each monument has a story to tell, many of the monuments may have additional information to provide in the book for you as well as expert driving directions. One can also purchase this book in advance via their website: sisqhistory.org at the “shop” link.

Outdoor Museum walking self-guided Tour: Visit the Siskiyou County Museum and ask to visit the outdoor museum. The outdoor museum has placards that give information about many of the structures along with a QR Code that will direct you to a webpage with more in-depth information about the buildings you are viewing.
